INTRODUCTION

- This presentation is on two (2) major Government Flagship programmes in Education in the Adansi Asokwa District

1. Free Senior High School

2. School Feeding Programme

FREE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (FREE SHS)

The Adansi Asokwa District like all other Districts in the country has benefited immensely from the Free SHS programme that was introduced by the NPP Government led by His Excellency Nana Addo Dankwa Akuffo Addo in 2017

The District has only one Public SHS (Bodwesango SHS)

So far the number of Free SHS beneficiaries in the school is 2880, made up of 1504 males and 1376 females

FREE SHS CONT'D

- BENEFITS OF FREE SHS
- Increased enrolment (from 1081 in 2016/2017 to 1911 in 2022)
- Employment opportunities for Teaching and Non teaching staff
 - 17 teaching Staff and 33 Non-Teaching staff have been employed over the period
- More Secondary school Graduates

FREE SHS CONT'D

- MAJOR PROJECTS COMPLETED IN THE PERIOD
- 2- STOREY BOYS DORMITORY BLOCK
- 1- STOREY GIRLS DORMITORY BLOCK
- 6-UNIT CLASSROOM BLOCK
- TOYOTA HILUX PICK UP VEHICLE
- SCHOOL BUS
- MECHANIZED BOREHOLE WITH OVERHEAD POLY TANK (BY DISTRICT ASSEMBLY)

SCHOOL FEEDING PROGRAMME

- Adansi Asokwa District continues to benefit from School Feeding Programme. There are currently 64 Schools with Kindergarten and Primary pupils. 19 of these schools are beneficiaries of School Feeding Programme which employs 19 different caterers.
- The total number of pupils benefiting from school feeding now is 6071 pupils comprising 3125 boys and 2946 girls who are beneficiaries of the programme.
